



## Central Library, IIT Bhubaneswar

The Central Library plays a vital role in supporting and furthering the academic and research mission of IIT Bhubaneswar and facilitates the creation and dissemination of knowledge. It offers a range of high-quality services on par with modern libraries of international standards in India. The library began its operations in July 2009 in a 300 sq. ft. room at IIT Kharagpur extension center Bhubaneswar, with an initial collection of 2,300 textbooks. On April 1, 2011, it moved to Toshali Bhawan, Satya Nagar, expanding to 2,200 sq. ft. In 2016, it extended its services to the institute's permanent campus at Argul, Khordha, before completely shifting there in 2018. Currently, the library occupies 40,000 sq. ft. across the 4th and 5th floors of the Administrative Building at IIT Bhubaneswar, Argul, Khordha. It is a fully computerized library, providing seamless access to all subscribed resources and services. Since its establishment, the library has continuously expanded its collections, services, and technology, ensuring the best support for its users.

### LIBRARY VISION AND MISSION

**Vision:** Empowering IIT Bhubaneswar's research and learning community with enriching collections, innovative services, and state-of-the-art technologies strengthened by strategic partnerships with national and international library networks.

**Mission:** Central Library promises to promote the IIT Bhubaneswar's mission as well as to discover, preserve, and disseminate knowledge. It engages with the ongoing technological transformations to deliver world-class physical and digital content and services significant to education, research, publication, and outreach.

## LIBRARY MEMBERSHIP

The library membership will be suspended or terminated, and disciplinary action will be taken, if the member has done any of the following:

- Found misusing/mutilating/stealing/cutting pages from a book
- Improper use of Library facilities

## BORROWING PRIVILEGES AND OVERDUE FINE

Only Registered Members can borrow books from the Central Library on the production of their individual Identity Card issued by the institute at the circulation desk. Each book issued to the user(s) must get a proper gate pass which they have to surrender at the checkpoint to the security. The entitlement of the number of books on loan and loan period with an overdue fine for different categories of members are as follows:

## RENEWAL OF BOOKS

If a loan book is not on-demand, then the user concerned is allowed for renewal a maximum of two consecutive times. The renewal of books can be done through the Library Catalog / WebOPAC or with the help of library staff at the circulation counter. The library reserves the right to recall any book issued to the user at any point in time if the need arises.

## RESERVATION AND OVERDUE OF BOOKS

- Members can reserve up to three books currently borrowed by others. Reservations can be made via WebOPAC or with staff assistance at the circulation counter.
- Books must be returned or renewed by the due date to avoid a fine of Rs. 1.00 per day per book. All overdue fines must be cleared before the academic session ends, or loan privileges will be suspended.
